The award is valued at \$2500 and may be held concurrently with a major award such as a Natural Sciences and Engineering Research Council Postgraduate Scholarship, a Social Sciences and Humanities Research Council Fellowship, or a University of Victoria Fellowship. Department	February	<b>LIEUTENANT-GOVERNOR'S SILVER MEDALS</b> The Lieutenant-Governor's Silver Medals are awarded annually to two students in Master's degree programs within the Faculty of Graduate Studies. One medal is awarded on the basis of overall academic excellence and an outstanding thesis, and one medal is awarded on the basis of overall program achievement and an outstanding project, extended essay, recital, exhibition or production. Selection of the recipient will be made by the Faculty of Graduate Studies Admissions and Awards Committee.	Silver Medal

The Howard E. Petch Scholarships are tenable for one year only for a post-graduate program. Selection will be made by the Graduate Admissions and Awards Committee.	\$7,500
Department	September	<b>PRESIDENT'S RESEARCH SCHOLARSHIPS</b> The Faculty of Graduate Studies offers President's Research Scholarships of \$4,000 to all students holding NSERC, SSHRC and CIHR awards valued at \$25,000 or less. Students who have been successful in Canadian national competitions where awards are a value between \$15,000 and \$25,000 are eligible to receive a \$2,000 President's Research Scholarships. There is no application process. In September of each year, the Faculty of Graduate Studies will request that each academic unit forward names of eligible students.	\$2,000

The David F. Strong Scholarship is tenable for one year only for a post-graduate program. Selection will be made by the Graduate Admissions and Awards Committee.	\$7,500
Department	February 15	<b>UNIVERSITY OF VICTORIA FELLOWSHIPS</b> Up to \$13,500 (Master's) and \$15,000 (Ph.D.) may be awarded by the Faculty of Graduate Studies to students of high academic standing registered full time in the Faculty as candidates or provisional candidates for a degree. All new applicants are evaluated for University Fellowships. The minimum standard required for consideration is an "A-" (First Class Standing). Grade calculations and equivalencies are determined by the Graduate Admissions and Records Office. Admissions applications must be complete by February 15 in order to be considered. Normally, awards are available for those entering in September only. The competition for University of Victoria Fellowships is very difficult.
